The Eunpyeong District Public Library, located near the scenic BukHans Mountain, opened on October 15th 2001. Eunpyeong Library was established by the Eunpyeong District Office and operated by the InDeoWoo Social Welfare Corporation. This is the first public library to be operated by a nongovernmental organization.

In the current informational age, our mission is to serve the public as the finest library as well as a cultural multiplex center by growing and developing in line with the community. Our entire staff, in addition to the librarians, will spare no efforts in providing a wide variety of resources that encompass the full range of the latest intellectual & educational information, premium services, and life-long education to every person in our community.



General Material Room

We provide books on a wide range of subjects to users above middle school age.

Children's Reading Room

To facilitate children (over 3) to form good reading habits, an enjoyable reading environment and various high quality materials are provided.

Periodicals

Available to all users of the library, latest magazines and newspapers on a wide range of subjects, such as current events, subjects for general education, culture, academic subjects, and lifestyles are available.

Reference Room

Anyone over the age of 13 or of the age of middle school students can access a wide variety of reference materials such as statistics, dictionaries, encyclopedias, maps, etc.

Digital Material Room

This room is designed to play the roles of the "Digital Library" and "Multimedia Center" so anyone over the age of 13 or middle school students can access PCs, various media materials and online services, etc.

Mobile Library Service

To enable residents in remote areas to access library resources, a mobile library bus seating 35 people runs a circuit through 10 areas in the region.

Room for the Visually Impaired

For people who have difficulties gaining access to cultural and informational services because of physical limitations, we provide a reading environment specifically designed for visually impaired people. Also, we provide education to improve their ability to access information so they are empowered to participate in social activities.

The 3rd Space

In order to accomplish the roles of a cultural center, various multimedia contents are played and social club activities are held.



Special Events

Writing Contest

Writing contests are held throughout the year to promote local residents' interest in literature and creativity.



Children's Book Exhibition Seasonal exhibits of illustrated books, fairy tales, and photography

Outdoor Movie Festival Films for the entire family are shown outdoors



Culture Classes

Open classes on various hobbies, general culture, and skills development.

Illustrated Poetry Exhibits

The library lobby is used as a venue for seasonal exhibits of illustrated poetry, original fairy tale illustrations, photographic works, and miscellaneous works produced in culture classes, etc.

Meet the Author

Authors are invited to deliver lectures using literature as the medium. Articles that facilitate the in-depth understanding of each author's literary work is provided.

Filial Piety Project

This is a special project providing online and offline materials on filial piety to local community residents. Its purpose is to maintain and promote the beautiful Korean tradition of filial piety.

Study Room open 24 hours

Providing a quiet and comfortable study hall for those wishing to study overnight.

Special Lectures

Providing useful information to local residents (updates on college entrance exams, sex education for youths, lectures on promoting children's interest in reading, etc.)
